To execute a major upgrade of computer technologies managed by the State of New Jersey Judiciary Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), the NJ Department of the Treasury has selected BANC3 to provide professional data processing system services.

The National Center for State Courts (NCSC) recently conducted a study in New Jersey with a twofold objective: To determine the Information Technology requirements of the state's courts, and to prepare a master plan to delineate the development and implementation of the computer systems necessary to satisfy those requirements. Once installed, the selected upgrades—including Web, network and database technologies—will enable the state Judiciary to meet the current demands of the daily operations of its courts.

Among its systems currently in use, the AOC Data Center maintains operations on two IBM Z-series mainframes which support approximately 2,500 MTX network computers, 9,500 personal computers, 5,000 printers, and 530 communications controllers. The AOC Systems Network architecture consists of 75 analog leased lines supporting over 550 locations. Over 10,000 users are currently utilizing AOC Local Area Networks located throughout the State. New systems will permit more rapid and efficient case processing through automated capabilities such as docketing, indexing, and completion of court forms. They will also assist in court management by providing effective monitoring of case status and court workloads. BANC3 has been selected to provide
