

BANC3 Awarded Two Engineering Contracts

CRANBURY, NJ—Two New Jersey public entities recently contracted BANC3 Consulting Engineers to provide professional engineering and staffing services for distinct improvement projects. While one project addresses public safety, the other supports the state's ongoing education initiatives in special needs Abbott districts.

East Windsor Township selected BANC3 to perform civil engineering designs and construction inspection for improvements to sections of Dutch Neck Road and One Mile Road between Route 130 and County Route 571. As this area contains the Township's Police Headquarters and Municipal Court building, East Windsor Volunteer Fire Company No. 1, and East Windsor Rescue Squad District 1, it is a vital component of public safety. Deteriorating curbs, potholes, and clogged stormwater grates require repair or replacement. Therefore, the township designated road improvements which include reconstruction, resurfacing with Superpave, striping, and turf restoration. Stormwater inlets will be upgraded to meet current state environmental and safety regulations. Other actions, such as replacement of curbing and driveway aprons, will be addressed individually as required.

BANC3 has already begun work on the initial phase of the project. We have completed a site review with the Township engineer to establish repair priorities. Our survey crew prepared field measurements and topographic surveys to identify all surface features of the roads. With this collected data, our staff engineer is currently preparing engineering designs.

Our second contract award is from the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA); BANC3 will provide professional staffing services for school facility construction and rehabilitation projects.
